

POOL FIRST AID KIT

In Manitoba, swimming pools must have a readily accessible, properly stocked first aid kit under the control of a lifeguard or operator. The first aid kit must be in compliance with the **Swimming Pools and Other Water Recreational Facilities Regulation C.C.S.M. c. P210 Part 1, s10** | [VIEW](#)

POOL FIRST AID KIT INVENTORY LIST (PUBLIC HEALTH P210, SCHEDULE B)

- 1 spine board with attached adjustable straps (not required at a wading pool or whirlpool)
- 2 blankets
- 12 safety pins
- 1 splinter tweezers, blunt nose
- 1 pair of bandage scissors, approximately 10 cm long
- First Aid Manual, Current Edition
- An approved antiseptic
- Disposable gloves
- Artificial Resuscitation barrier device or Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation barrier device (not required at a wading pool) DRESSINGS (individually wrapped)
- 2 sterile bandage compresses, approximately 10 cm x 10 cm
- 8 sterile pads, approximately 7 cm x 7 cm
- 32 sterile adhesive dressings, approximately 2.5 cm wide
- 2 sterile gauze compresses, approximately 1 m x 1 m BANDAGES
- 1 triangular bandage, approximately 1 m on all sides
- 2 roller bandages, approximately 5 cm x 6 m
